Note to catechist: Copy and cut out the slips below, making enough sets for your students to complete **Commandments 1, 2, and 3** in pairs.

Not doing unnecessary work on Sunday.	Beginning prayers with “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.”	Keeping promises you make to God.
Putting God first in everything.	Having a crucifix on your wall or wearing a crucifix.	Praying a Rosary.
Reading the Bible.	Spending time with family on Sunday.	Respecting your friends and classmates as God’s creatures.
Saying prayers each morning and each night.	Praying before meals.	Thanking God for the good things in your life.
Asking God’s help with challenges in your life.	Trusting in God.	Speaking the Lord’s name with reverence.
Honoring the saints.	Going to Confession before receiving Communion if you have committed a serious sin.	Going to Mass on Sunday.
Speaking our Lady’s name with respect.	Resting on Sunday, as the Lord rested after He created the world.	Going to Holy Mass on holy days of obligation.
