The Spirit of the Lord is
upon me, because
[h]e has **anointed** me.

–Isaiah 61:1a

Jesus is the
Messiah,
which means
anointed one.

For my thirst they
gave me **vinegar**.

–Psalm 69:22b

Jesus was thirsty
on the Cross.
He was given
vinegar to drink.

[The LORD] has sent me to bring **good news** to the afflicted.

–Isaiah 61:1b

The word Gospel means the **Good News** of salvation in Jesus Christ.

Behold a **virgin shall conceive, and bear a son.**

–Isaiah 7:14b
(Douay-Reims)

The Virgin Mary gave birth to a son: Jesus.

I, the LORD, have called you... to **open the eyes of the blind.**

–Isaiah 42:6-7

Jesus gave **sight to the blind.**

He bore the punishment that makes us whole, by his wounds we were healed.

–Isaiah 53:5b

Jesus died for our sins in order to heal our relationship with the Father.
