

## Prophecy Cards

**Catechist Note:** Cut out the cards and give one to each student (you may need to make multiple sets). Each student should read the information on his or her card and find a classmate whose card “matches” (i.e., is similar in content and fits together in shape).

<p>From [<b>Bethlehem</b>] shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel. —Micah 5:1</p>	<p>Jesus was born in <b>Bethlehem</b>.</p>
<p>The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because [he] has <b>anointed</b> me. —Isaiah 61:1a</p>	<p>Jesus is the Messiah, which means <b>anointed one</b>.</p>
<p>For my thirst they gave me <b>vinegar</b>. —Psalm 69:22b</p>	<p>Jesus was thirsty on the Cross. He was given <b>vinegar</b> to drink.</p>

[The LORD] has sent me to bring **good news** to the afflicted.

The word Gospel means the **Good News** of salvation in Jesus Christ.

Behold a **virgin shall conceive, and bear a son.**

**The Virgin Mary gave birth to a son: Jesus.**

Jesus gave **sight to the blind.**

He bore the punishment that makes us whole, by his wounds we were **healed.**
