

# SERVICE PROJECT SUGGESTIONS



We will not hold a traditional Community Meeting this month. Instead, you will work with other families to perform a service project of your choice. Please plan to carry out your project during the scheduled meeting day/time of our Community Meeting.

When deciding on your community service project, let yourselves be inspired by the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. For example:

- ▶ Prepare and deliver meals for a new mother, an elderly person, or anyone who may have a need. (Feed the hungry.)
- ▶ Organize and work a drink station at a local charity race. (Give drink to the thirsty.)
- ▶ Knit blankets, hats, and scarves for a local pregnancy help center. (Clothe the naked.)
- ▶ Create and distribute Easter cards to people in local prisons. (Visit the imprisoned.)
- ▶ Bring flowers to a cemetery to leave at grave sites that do not have any (being sure to respect the cemetery's rules). Pray for the people buried there. (Bury the dead; pray for the living and the dead.)
- ▶ Volunteer at a local homeless shelter or battered women's center. (Shelter the homeless, comfort the afflicted.)
- ▶ Pray at an abortion clinic for those who have lost their lives there, as well as for women considering abortion. (Pray for the living and the dead.)
- ▶ Volunteer with a ministry that provides post-abortion healing such as Rachel's Vineyard. (Comfort the afflicted.)
- ▶ Volunteer with a ministry providing literacy support, job training, or other services to those who need them. (Instruct the ignorant.)
